CSAA Membership Categories

General Membership: Open to professional and civic not-for-profit arts organizations and municipality that sponsored arts events, exhibits and performances.

Associate Membership: Open to arts organizations that are for-profit or do not fall under the above Membership criteria. Acceptance of applications in this category is at the discretion of the CSAA Board.

Individual Membership: Open to individual professional artists working in the fine arts.

Dues are based on organization budgets or a minimum of \$50/year.

Educational institutions that present civic or professional arts events in their facilities or auditoriums are eligible for membership, but CSAA does not promote school-based academic activities.

The geographic location of applying arts organizations and individuals must be within the Chicago Southland region, which consists primarily of southern Cook County and Will County. Acceptance of applications is at the discretion of the CSAA Board.
